ULKATCHO BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTION

Whereas: the COVID-19 Virus outbreak has the potential for a significant impact on the health and welfare of the residents of Canada, British Columbia and the Ulkatcho First Nation and the British Columbia Government has declared a State of Emergency.

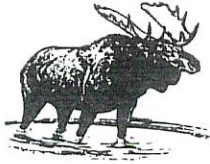
Therefore: Let it be resolved that:

STATE OF EMERGENCY – PUBLIC ALERT / TRAVEL LIMITATIONS ON COMMUNITY LANDS

For the safety of our members and all British Columbians, the Ulkatcho First Nation has declared a State of Emergency and has declared that the community of Ulkatcho First Nation is now in a lockdown for precautionary reasons related to COVID-19.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

- **ONLY RESIDENTS/MEMBERS UNDER ESSENTIAL TRAVEL** that only community members to be allowed into the community and will be required to adhere to a 14-day quarantine (self-isolation) period. Members not ordinarily resident in the community should not return to the community but should instead remain where they normally reside and follow the local authority's COVID-19 safety guidelines.
- **NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVELLERS & NON-RESIDENTS:**
 - Signage will be posted directing non-essential travelers to not enter the community
 - will be asked to TURN AROUND and not enter the community, or
 - for TRAVELLERS & NON-RESIDENTS traveling through the community to their destination, NO STOPS WILL BE PERMITTED.
- **DELIVERIES OF GOODS & SERVICES**, will be allowed into the community, with minimal contact with community members.
- **ESSENTIAL TRAVEL IN THE COMMUNITY**, you are directed to **Stay Home** and only travel within the community for essential needs. Health, food, and essential services.
- **ACCESS TO STORES**; Stores are to limit access, maintain a limit of no more than 5 customers at a time in the store. Individual stores have the right to reduce this amount. You are directed to adhere to the policy of the store.

- **GROUP GATHERINGS**, all group events are cancelled, this includes but is not limited to; sports and recreation, fishing parties and other social and community gatherings, church services. house parties and other types of large gatherings are to be discontinued.
- **Hunting/Gathering** – you are to abide by the current rules, regulations and guidelines regarding hunting and harvesting of animals. Do not harvest Moose Cows or Caribou.

Failure to respect this Emergency Order may result in enforcement actions and penalties by the Ulkatcho First Nation. Penalties could entail the removal of additional COVID19 support monies for people to be found in contravention of the directives in this resolution.

It is imperative that the community is healthy and to do so we require the assistance of all community members. Ignoring the recommendations will put all members of the community at risk. With Elders being one of the most vulnerable groups. Please show respect for the Elders by abiding by the details of this resolution.
