- Be able to assess, evaluate and give feedback to students and parents on their work – this will include report cards
- Be willing to work with a school team to further students' educational goals
- Willing to continue learning by attending language/culture courses and workshops and other professional development activities

The successful applicant may be required to obtain a Language Certificate through the Teacher Regulation Branch in the absence of a Professional Teaching Certificate.

The instructor will work under the direct supervision of the Ulkatcho First Nation Education Director.
