RE: Evacuation Fire Alert

WHEREAS The Ulkatcho First Nation supports an immediate Evacuation Alert at Eliguk Lake as an extension of the Evacuation Order at Gatcoh Lake (see attached map)


WHEREAS: The Wildfire in the area is imminently threatening the Ulkatcho First Nation Reserve/Territory.

AND WHEREAS and if Applicable: the Cariboo Chilcotin Regional District and/or the Coastal regional District has declared a State of Local Emergency due to the existing threat.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Ulkatcho First Nation Chief & Council Declaration of a State of Local Emergency (SOLE) for assurance of an Evacuation Alert. The Ulkatcho First Nation Council hereby declares a State of Local Emergency pursuant to the authority of the Chief & Council as per its funding agreement with Canada which outlines that Chief and Council "shall always provide for the preservation of public health and safety and the prevention of the environment".

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: the Ulkatcho First Nation, employees, servants, and agents are empowered by a duly signed Band Council Resolution to work in collaboration with the primary response agency to perform all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency, including:


- Acquire or use any land or personal property considered necessary to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.
- Authorize or require any person to render assistance of a type that the person is qualified to provide or that otherwise is or may be required to prevent, respond to, or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.
- Control or prohibit travel to or from any area designated in the declaration within the Band Council's jurisdiction.
- Provide for the restoration of essential facilities and the distribution of essential supplies and provide, maintain and coordinate emergency medical, welfare and other essential services in any part of the Band Council's jurisdiction.
- Coordinate and assist in the implementation of an evacuation of persons, livestock, animals and personal property from any area designated in the declaration of the Band Council's jurisdiction that is or may be affected by an emergency or a disaster and to ensure the adequate care and protection of those persons, livestock, animals and personal property.
- Authorize the entry into any building or on any land, without warrant, by any person in the course of implementing an emergency management plan or program or if otherwise considered by the Band Council to be necessary to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.
- Coordinate and implement the demolition or removal of any trees, structures or crops that are considered within the declaration of the Band Council's jurisdiction to be necessary or appropriated to prevent, respond to, or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.
- Coordinate and assist in the implementation of construction work considered within the declaration of the Band Council's jurisdiction to be necessary or appropriate to prevent, respond to, or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.


